### Background/Eligibility/Registration

**Background:** National 4-H Congress has been a premiere nation-wide opportunity for 4-H members across America for more the 96 years. Originally held in Chicago, the event is now held in the “Capitol of the South”, Atlanta, Georgia during Thanksgiving break.

National 4-H Congress is a five-day event in Atlanta, GA, that engages high school aged 4-H members in leadership, citizenship, global awareness, and inclusion. Participants not only have the opportunity to participate in state-of-the-art educational workshops and hear from world-renowned speakers, they also have the opportunity to network with other 4-H members from across the United States.

National 4-H Congress delegates have an opportunity to increase knowledge, resources, and skills that will empower them to make an impact on their community in a meaningful and genuine way.

**Eligibility:** Grand Champion Senior Exhibits at the State Fair in 32 project areas are eligible for the trip. A list of projects is available in the Event Information area above. A 4-H member can only attend this trip once in their 4-H career. State Fair Contests and Livestock projects are not eligible for this trip. **Registration:** Eligible 4-H members will receive a postcard after the exhibits have been judged. Then these eligible 4-H members will register through 4HOnline.

**Cost:** The Colorado 4-H Foundation pays 1/3 of the costs with 2/3 of the costs the responsibility of the 4-H member. The cost varies because of the cost of airfare but typically runs between \$700-\$800 per person
