- Do at least three required activities and four optional activities (Brain Boosters) each year. Check them off on page 5 of the manual. Be sure to list day, month, and year for the completed activities.
- Be sure to have your leader or parent initial each activity.
- Take part in at least two leadership experiences each year.
- Be sure to include your completed manual with your Electric e-record in a secure binder.
- If you plan to take the unit for more than one year, make sure that each exhibit is different each year.
- Entering Electronics is for a more advanced senior 4-H member.
- Enter your project in the county fair.
- Share information learned in talks and displays.

Judging Criteria:

- Completeness of manual and e-record.
- E-record includes demonstrations, talks, story, and pictures, with at least one action shot of you doing something with your project.
- Neatness and legibility.
- How you completed your activities and the quality of your exhibit.
