Project Tips:

- Do at least seven activities and Booster Shots each year as listed in each manual. Any combination of activities and Booster Shots can be done. For example, in Chapter 1, "Airedales to Zebras," the activities are: Breed Apart, Basic Needs, Fur and Feathers as Friends and More, Get Growin', System Check, Body Language, Animal Style, and What's for Lunch. Booster Shots are listed on pages 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17 and 19. So you might choose five activities from the three chapters and two Booster Shots for a combination of seven, or another similar combination of seven.
- Make sure to list the activities and Booster Shots that you have done on page 4 of the manual with date of completion and your leader's or parent's initials.
- Be sure to attach the Booster Shots activities after the manual and before the e-record in a secured, sturdy binder.
- Do the activities in the manual.
- Look up information in the library or on the internet.
- Visit with your veterinarian.
- Take trips and tours.
- Enter your project in the county fair.
- Share information learned in talks and displays.

Judging Criteria:

- Completeness of answers.
- E-record includes demonstrations, talks, story, and pictures, with at least one action shot of you working on your project.
- Neatness and legibility.
- How you completed your activities and the quality of your exhibit.
